On Tuesday 12<sup>th</sup> June, to celebrate our Art topic, Y2 are joining Y4 for an exciting trip to the Yorkshire Sculpture Park. During the first half of the Summer Term, the children have engaged with a range of creative activities, exploring a variety of artists and related skills. The opportunity to experience 3D installations and to make that connection of art with space on this educational visit will really enhance our learning journey.
